What is pancreatic cancer?

Pancreatic cancer is a type of cancer that starts in the cells of the pancreas, the organ that produces digestive enzymes and insulin.

Because the early stages of pancreatic cancer do not often cause symptoms, it is occasionally referred to as the "silent killer." Pancreatic cancer is mostly diagnosed at an advanced stage of the disease, so the prognosis is generally devastating.

Highlights:

Because of its low survival rate, pancreatic cancer is the fourth leading cause of cancer death for both sexes.

5 500 new cases will be diagnosed this year.

4 800 patients will die of the disease.

1 in 74 men and **1 in 72 women** risk developing pancreatic cancer in their lifetime.

1 in 72 men and 1 in 66 women will lose their battle to this disease.

The 5-year survival rate is very low at 8%.
